CARE ADVICE: **LEATHER PRODUCTS**





Congratulations on the purchase of your new leather furniture!

- You will be happy to learn that leather furniture in a normal domestic environment should need little attention. Although it is not essential for leather to be cleaned as regularly as fabric upholstery covers the accumulation of household contamination and dust is unwelcome and should be dealt with before it becomes too difficult to remove
- It's worth remembering that leather is a natural product that can have scars and blemishes. Rather than being a fault, this is actually a characteristic of leather that should be cherished, and makes your furniture a unique.
- If natural body oils are aloud to build up on the leather this can cause staining and a breakdown of the leather surface, so its important to use one of our specific cleaning products to remove it.
- Prolonged direct sunlight is also harmful to leather.
- Dust regularly using a soft lint-free cloth
- Vacuum regularly if possible, using a soft brush attachment. Always remember to clean between the cushions and down between the seats and arms as crumbs and fluff can cause premature wear
- Wipe away liquid spills and stains using a soft moist cloth and if necessary mild soap solution. Do not soak the leather and if it becomes over wet remove excess liquid and allow it to dry naturally.

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- Do not use household detergents, wax or spray polish or any proprietary brand fluids or abrasive cleaners on the leather as this will damage its surface.
- If the surface of the leather becomes scuffed, scratched, or damaged in any way or the surface changes colour then contact a leather specialist for advice and/or repair.
