Congratulations on purchasing your new mattress!

Here are a few tips to keep it performing at its best for many years to come.

- When you receive your mattress, it's important to remove it from its packaging and stand it on its side in a well-ventilated, or next to an open window.
- Your new mattress will feel very different to your old one, so you must give it time to settle in and allow your body to adjust to the new feel. This can take a few weeks to happen so don't worry.
- Always use a mattress protector as this will protect your mattress from body moisture and allergens such as dust mites. It will also avoid unnecessary staining that could void your warranty.
- It's important to turn and rotate your mattress monthly. For non-turn mattresses it's still very important to rotate. This will allow the mattress to settle evenly.
- It's important to use the handles to turn and rotate, if they are fitted to the side of your mattress.
- If just purchasing a mattress make sure the base of the bed is of a good quality and offers adequate support.
- Make sure you have good access, as bending or twisting of the mattress will void its warranty.
